A.M.Shaikh Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital & PG Research Centre conducted a workshop on Curriculum Redesigning of MD Homoeopathic Course organized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The chief guest for the event was Dr. Girish Sonvalkar, Deputy Registrar of the Regional Centre at RGUHS, Bangalore.
